LATEST NOTICE ABOUT THE EASING OF COVID RESTRICTIONS RECEIVED FROM BISHOPS CONFERENCE

'The legal requirement to wear face coverings in churches in Scotland will be removed from Monday 4th April. Individuals may continue to wear face coverings if they wish to do so, and this should be respected.

In the meantime, please continue to observe the following basic principles:

- Please respect the space of fellow parishioners where possible
- Hands should be sanitised on entering and exiting the Church
- Continue to ensure good ventilation

Please note that the legal requirement to wear face coverings will be removed for the church building. Therefore, the change will apply to all activities which take place within the church building and not just to acts of worship.'

Please ensure that the following mitigations are applied:

At the Unveiling of the Cross on Good Friday, the Cross **ought not to be kissed**: a simple bow will suffice for the purpose of reverence.

Cleaning regimes may revert to pre pandemic levels

Sign of peace (involving touch) still to be discontinued

Confessionals not to be used, due to lack of ventilation

Feet may be washed during the Mass of the Lord's Supper, if that is the custom

Protocols surrounding Holy Communion to continue as they are at present, and for the foreseeable future.
