

CATECHISM

Classes to prepare children to receive the Sacraments of Reconciliation (formerly First Confession), First Holy Communion and Confirmation will commence on September 11th, and be held every Monday between 4.30 -5.30 in St Fergus. Karolina and Angela are looking forward to helping children prepare to receive these Sacraments. A short meeting for parents and children will be held **after 11.15 Mass on Sunday 3rd September at St. Fergus.** Reconciliation and First Communion are usually received in P4, but older children are of course very welcome. Children are usually confirmed in P7, and again older children are also welcome. Please let Father know if your wish your child to receive Sacraments next Spring/Summer.

Children's liturgy

Angela is looking forward to welcoming any children who wish to attend children's liturgy during some 11.15 Masses at St Fergus. Children will be invited by Father to go to the back room after the opening prayers where they will listen to the Gospel message and learn about our loving God at their own level. There will also be a hands-on activity, (usually a craft activity), after which children will return to their families at the Offertory. Parent/grandparent also welcome to come with their child to see what we are doing, as this is a new experience. Children's liturgy will be available following an almost fortnightly pattern, dates displayed at the back of the church. No children's liturgy this week, but next one on Sept 3rd.
