#### ***Right To Life Against Assisted Dying Petition***

Right to Life.org.uk have previously set up an On-line petition which sent a letter of objection to the MP for the constituency in which one resides. Because the 3<sup>rd</sup> and final reading and ballot on the Leadbeater bill takes place in the House of Commons on June 20<sup>th</sup>, Right to Life have promoted a hand-written petition, which will be sent to each MP, pertinent to the constituency in which they represent. A copy of the petition has been supplied to both St Fergus' and St Anthony's for inclusion by those parishioners who oppose the passing of the Bill. As the result will be very close, with many of the MPs who abstained, now veering against the Bill, every effort has to be made to show your MP, the strength of feeling against the Bill. I need to forward our petition sheets to Right To Life by 6pm on Monday 16<sup>th</sup> June. I hope as many as possible will sign by Sunday 15<sup>th</sup>, to convince our MPs to do likewise. I shall collect then process after Sunday Masses. Thank you, Geoff Bray.

#### **Bishop Andrew's Pastoral Visit**

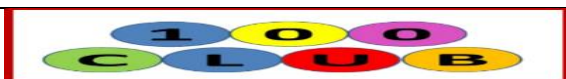
