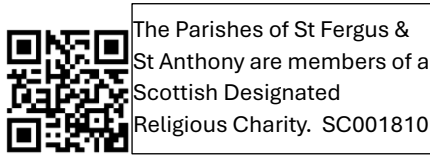

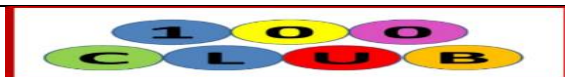
Altar Servers' day Out – June 22nd
