Adoration of The Blessed Sacrament

This Rite is now included as a prelude to Mass in both St Fergus' and St Anthony's at the following times:

Thursday – St Fergus' at 0930 to 1000 before Holy Mass Friday – St Anthony's at 0900 to 0930 before Holy Mass Sunday – St Anthony's at 0845 to 0915 before Holy Mass

St John Mary Vianney – Priest (1786-1859) had to contend with poverty, military service and his own intellectual shortcomings to become a priest. In 1817, he was sent to care for the people of Ars, a small obscure French village. The marvellous gift of the unlearned priest for seeing into the depths of the soil, brought the world to Ars. From 1830 on, the Cure averaged 12 to 16 hours a day in the confessional.

St Dominic b. c.1170. Born in the area of Old Castile. Domingo Guzman studied at Palencia and was made a canon of the church in 1193 at Osma. His Bishop took him on a political mission to the South of France, travelling from place to place, converting the people, the followers of a heretic, and established The Order of Preachers – the Dominicans. He took part in the 1215 Fourth Lateran Council where the Order received approval. The order spread rapidly, and there were 60 houses, when he died in 1261.

St Teresa Benedicta of The Cross (1891-1942). Virgin and Martyr, born of Jewish parents in Breslau, Germany, (now Wroclaw, Poland). Edith Stein was a brilliant student, gaining her doctorate in philosophy aged 25. At 31 converted to Catholicism and became a Carmelite Nun in 1934. Being Jewish, she fled to The Netherlands when the Nazi's took power in Germany, but following the German invasion of the Low Countries in 1940, she was seized by the Nazis and sent to Auschwitz, where she suffered the gas chambers on August 9th 1942.
