Notes from The Liturgical Calendar For Scotland

St Bernard (1090-1153) – Theologian and reformer, was born near Dijon, becoming a Cistercian Monk at Citeaux in 1112 and abbot of the new monastery of Clairvaux in 1115. Noted for his asceticism, knowledge and eloquence, he is regarded as the last of the Fathers of The Church. He founded more than 70 monasteries, drew up the statutes of the Knights Templar and kindled enthusiasm for the 2nd Crusade. He was a deeply pious and skilful teacher of the Faith, as well as an uncompromising opponent of those who disagreed with him. "The Memorare" prayer is ascribed to him.

St Pius X (1835-1914). Born of humble parents in Riese near Venice, Giuseppe Sarto. Ordained to the priesthood in 1858 and successively became Bishop of Mantua in 1884, cardinal Patriarch of Venice in 1893 and Pope in 1903. He fostered liturgy as a pastoral gift, encouraged frequent reception of the Holy Eucharist and decreed that First Communion should take place around the age of 7. The movement called Modernism became widespread in various areas of the Church and Pius X issued a severe condemnation of it and the excommunication of several prominent adherents.

<u>The Queenship of The Blessed Virgin Mary</u> – this feast is celebrated on the octave day of the solemn feast of her Assumption, dates from the close of the Marian year of 1955. Mary is rightly honoured as our Mother and Queen, as is her Assumption, because of her role while on earth.
