### Notes from The Liturgical Calendar For Scotland

St Monica (c.332-387) – was the North African Catholic woman whose prayers, pleading and example, helped both her husband Patricius and her son Augustine to be converted and Baptised. Augustine was in Milan where Monica went to see him baptised. They then went on their way back to Africa when Monica fell ill and died at Ostia, the then port of Rome. Her long, patient efforts & prayers for her husband & son are a model & inspiration to encourage many wives & mothers today. St Augustine (354-430). This great saint was born to Monica and Patricius in North Africa – present day Algeria. Highly intelligent he crossed to Europe and after a short time in Rome, went to Milan. Having a brilliant career there, but still not baptised, lived a somewhat dissolute life. He fathered a son - Adeodatus with a woman unknown. Encouraged by the presence of his mother, he received baptism and returned a committed Catholic to North Africa. Such was his renown that he was made Bishop of the city of Hippo. An outstanding writer and preacher, his books and sermons became – and still are – extremely influential in the Church. Among the Doctors of the Church, Saint Augustine occupies and illustrious position. Saint John The Baptist – was imprisoned by Herod Antipas, son of Herod the Great, for his heroic witness to the truth. Herod vowed to give Herodias daughter anything she asked as a reward: even half of his Kingdom. Instead, on her mother's instructions, she asked for John's head on a plate. John was therefore decapitated for proclaiming the way of The Lord. His death became the precursor to the Lord's own violent death, as he had been, in his remarkable birth and prophetic preaching.
