### Notes from The Liturgical Calendar For Scotland

<u>The Nativity of The Blessed Virgin Mary</u> – The Feast is celebrated nine months after the solemn feast of her Immaculate Conception. Mary's birth is recorded, not in Sacred Scripture but in the second century *Protoevangelium of James* which adds her parents' names as Anne and Joachim. In Jerusalem, near the Pool of Bethesda, there is a beautiful 5<sup>th</sup> century church of St Anne, reputed to be perhaps Mary's birthplace.

St John Chrysostum (347-407) The adjective 'Chrysostum' means 'golden mouthed' i.e. eloquent. He trained as an advocate, but after 6 years as a monk took holy orders – deacon, priest and in 398, archbishop of Constantinople. He built hospitals, reformed the clergy and sent monks to be missionaries. For being a critic of rulers, was deposed and banished in 403. In exile he died 4 years later. In 418 he was honourably reburied in Constantinople. He was recognised as a great orator, wrote homilies, commentaries of the scriptures, letters and a number of theological treaties. He is recognised as one of the four great Doctors of the Eastern Church


