

Advent Season: The season of Advent begins this weekend. The Advent season marks the beginning of a new Liturgical year. We begin Cycle A of Sundays and Solemnities and Year 1 of Weekdays. In Advent, the Church prepares to celebrate the Nativity of the Lord. The commemoration of the birth of Jesus recalls the first coming as we look forward in faith to His second coming at the end of time.

Advent Service: This Sunday, 30th November, is the first Sunday of Advent. To observe this special season and to help us prepare better for Christmas, we will be having Solemn Vespers with Benediction at SS Leonard and Fergus at 4pm on the four Sundays we have in Advent. We are all invited to be part of this.
